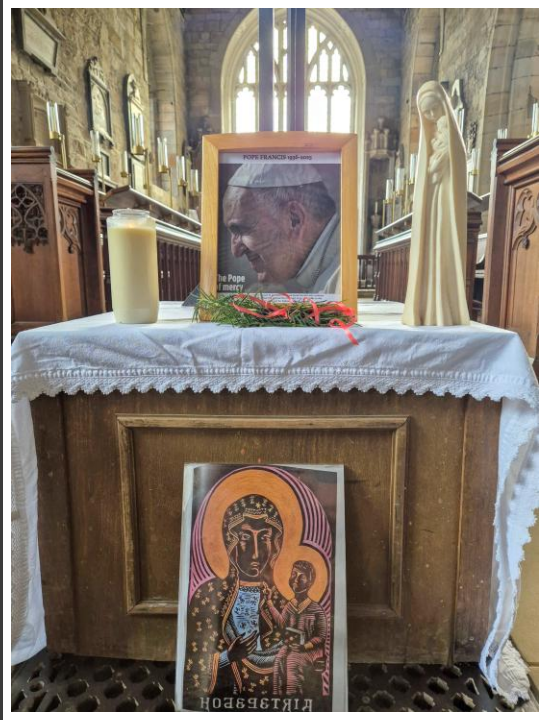
CHURCHWARDENS
